PK3

Bible

The PK3 curriculum focuses on familiar Bible stories emphasizing God's love for people, particularly children. These lessons are taken from various sources. Each lesson includes short, story related memory verses. We have daily prayer in the classroom as well as a weekly chapel service.

Manuscript Writing

Handwriting skills are taught through alphabet letter tracing, name writing, and proper formation of letters.

Phonics and Reading

The A Beka "Letters and Sounds" book focuses on letter and sound identification. Supplemental lessons are taught through literature, songs, poems, and special activities.

Math

The A Beka "Numbers and Skills with Button Bear" book provides readiness activities in mathematics for the PK3 student. Math activities introduce number concepts and the writing of numbers from 1-20.

Classroom Themes and Crafts

A favorite part of the preschool day is the theme of the week and the special activity to enhance letter recognition. This may be a special art project, show and tell, or even making a special snack. "Arts and Crafts with Amber Lamb" provides an enjoyable experience for everyone.
