Preschool Curriculum PK-4

Bible –We have daily prayer and devotions in the classroom as well as weekly chapel services. The Positive Action for Christ Bible curriculum focuses on studying God’s love and his salvation plan, memorizing scripture so that the children can learn to use the word of God in their daily lives, learning about prayer and its importance, and trusting in the promise of God in his word.

Manuscript Writing – The A Beka manuscript writing lays the foundation for the basic formation of each letter. The writing readiness program incorporates basic writing strokes into a concept of the “writing house” and uses this as the pattern for correct placement of letters on lines.

Phonics and Reading – Our reading program incorporates language interaction, thinking skills, good literature, and an introduction to sounds and reading. In addition, pre-reading and reading skills are taught through activities such as rhyming words, syllabication, onset rime and words in a sentence. Students learn to sound out blends, one and two vowel words, and read sentences.

Math – The A Beka ABC-123 Book provides readiness activities in mathematics and manuscript printing for the preschool student. Math activities introduce number concepts and the writing of numbers from 1-20. Math activities primarily focus on conceptual skills including patterning, graphing, measuring, estimation, as well as traditional practice in rote counting and set development.

Classroom Themes and Crafts – A favorite part of the preschool day is the theme of the week and the special activity to enhance letter recognition. This may be a special art project, science experiment, show and tell, or even making a special snack.
