

## Uniform FAQ's

- Do I have to purchase my student's uniforms at Levine's Department Store?  
**Yes, all required pieces of your students uniforms must be purchased through our uniform vendor, Levine's Department Store.**
  - Can I purchase any brand from Levine's Department Store?  
**No, all pants, shorts, skirts, skorts and jumpers must be Elderwear Brand. The approved polos and blazers are easy to locate as they already have the TSCA logo on them. You may choose any brand of Oxford.**
  - How do I know what size to choose for my student?  
**The helpful staff at Levine's will be able to help walk you through sizes and fits. They are aware that this is a new change for our families and are prepared to help make the transition as smooth as possible.**
  - Where can I get the detailed Uniform List?  
**You can access the required uniform list [here](#), or the Levine's staff has them available at the store.**
  - Does my student need everything on the Uniform List?  
**No, the list is broken down by boys and girls and also indicates which grade levels require which items. You will also find "optional" written next to items that are not required but are approved options for students to wear.**
  - Does my student need to wear their blazer everyday?  
**No, the uniform blazer is only required to be worn by high school students (9th-12th grade) as part of the Wednesday chapel uniform\*. They are, however, allowed to wear the blazer any other day of the week.**
- \*NOTE: Beginning in the 2019-2020 school year, the uniform blazer will be a required part of the high school students' daily (Monday-Thursday) uniform.***
- Once I get to Levine's, how do I locate the correct and approved uniform for my student?  
**The staff at Levine's has done a great job of labeling the approved uniforms with a sign that has our TSCA logo on it. They should be quite easy to find, but if you need help they are available to answer any and all questions.**
