

## **TSCA'S CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) STATUS UPDATE - REVISED APRIL 4, 2020**

Please note that the Dallas Morning News, along with other area media, incorrectly reported the new date for the stay-at-home order for Dallas County. (Please see the CORRECTED story [HERE.](#)) **The Editor's note from last night's correction stated the following:** "A subject line in an earlier version of this newsletter misstated the date of Dallas County's stay-at-home order. The order will remain in place until April 30, according to Dallas County Judge Clay Jenkins. *The Dallas Morning News* regrets the error." With that in mind, we have revised our original announcement made on April 3rd to reflect the correct stay-at-home order as determined by Judge Jenkins and the school's position on remaining closed.

**REVISED ANNOUNCEMENT:** The Governor issued an executive order, dated March 31, 2020, extending the closure of all public and private schools through May 4, 2020, due to COVID-19. On April 3, 2020, Judge Clay Jenkins extended his stay-at-home order for Dallas County to **April 30, 2020**. Given that the Governor's executive order directs schools to remain closed until May 4, 2020, we will remain closed through **May 4, 2020**. All events in April have been canceled. No events will be rescheduled.
