

STATUS OF TUITION & DAYCARE FEES, March 17, 2020

Dear TSCA Parents & Partners in Christian Education,

It's a new day, and we praise God for His goodness even in the midst of the chaos. He is faithful in all things! We are praying for you daily knowing that you are meeting with new challenges that you have never encountered before. May the Lord Our God guide your steps each day on this unprecedented journey! Please know that we appreciate your prayers for the TSCA faculty, staff, and their families, as we navigate this new landscape and continue to make multiple preparations to launch our home learning program to ensure we deliver quality learning opportunities for the time the school remains closed. We have one quarter (9 weeks) of instruction left, and we are praying that we can reopen the school before that period ends.

I will be in touch at a later date with specific information that you will need to successfully partner with TSCA faculty in the home learning environment. This email will focus solely on remaining tuition payments and before/after school day care for any children enrolled in the monthly program.

First, for those families who are enrolled in our daily before/after school day care program, we will be determining the amount that students who are enrolled in daycare need to be credited and apply it to their last payments in April and/or May. We can do no less. Although we are fully positioned to provide a home learning environment remotely, we cannot provide any daycare services, so we will credit your accounts. Kathryn Brooks will be reaching out as things settle down to report to each family the amount that will be credited on 10-month (April) and 11-month (May) payment plans. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we compile this data and complete the necessary steps to apply the credit against your accounts.

At this time, tuition payments will continue to be due as scheduled. For 10-month payment plans, only one payment remains. For 11-month payment plans, two payments remain. Of course, the exceptions to remaining payments due would be families that postponed or missed payments. More payments would remain in this scenario. These exceptions are individualized. If you fall into this last category, please feel free to reach out to Kathryn Brooks to determine how many payments you have remaining. Payments continue to be due on the 1st of the month or as outlined on your FACTS agreement.

Please know that we will be holding meetings in the upcoming weeks to create a feasible plan for those families whose jobs and income may be affected by the Coronavirus 15-day national shutdown, especially if it is determined that the shutdown must be extended for a longer period of time. Although all remaining tuition will still be due, we have always worked with our families in a time of crisis, and we will continue to do so on a case-by-case basis. TSCA continues to have operating expenses that must be honored for the

remainder of the fiscal year, so we will certainly consider the needs of families alongside TSCA's financial obligations to determine the best possible plan of action for the well-being of the school and the family.

If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to reach out to me. I check my email throughout the day, and lately, I am on the TSCA Gmail site at least 8-9 hours a day, so I am very accessible. My goal is to ensure we serve you with unwavering excellence, so your concern, questions, and feedback are important to us.
