EXTENDED SCHOOL CLOSURE AND TSCA E-LEARNING WEBSITE INFORMATION

Today, Governor Abbott **extended social distancing measures until April 30, 2020**, in keeping with President Trump's announcement on Sunday. In addition, he has now **extended school closures until May 4th**.
